Ans. Grace helps us to live as God wants to lead us. It helps us to act in God's love and makes us holy and pleasing to God.

Ans. We obey three commandments for God. The Commandments are:

- i. I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD. You shall not have strange Gods before me.

7. Answer the following questions:

a. What is Sacraments? Write about last three sacraments. (2+3)

Ans. Sacrament is a religious ceremony regarded as a sign/ symbol of grace. The last three sacraments are:

1. **Anointing of the sick:** The priest prays to God for the healing of the sick person. He blesses the sick person with the holy oil.
2. **Holy Orders:** When a catholic person dedicates his/ her life completely for God. The person serves the church to lead the people of God. Priests and Nuns receives the Holy orders.
3. **Matrimony:** The bride and the bridegroom decides to get married in the catholic church. They promise to live with each other all their life. They bring up their children in a Catholic faith.

b. How many commandments do we obey to respect people? Write them. (1+4)

Ans. We obey four commandments to respect people. The commandments are:

1. You shall not steal.
2. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbours.
3. You shall not covet your neighbour's wife/husband.
4. You shall not covet your neighbour's goods.

c. What is eternal life? Why did the rich young man come to Jesus? What did Jesus tell him? (2+1+2)

Ans. Eternal life is to know and believe in God. It is to love and serve God. It is to live with God forever. The rich man came to Jesus to know the way to receive eternal life. Jesus told the rich man to obey the Ten Commandments to receive Eternal life.

d. What is Prayer? Write the three ways of praying and explain. (2+3)

Ans. Prayer is a medium through which we get connected to our God. The three ways of praying are:

1. Vocal Prayer: When we pray using our voice.
2. Meditation: When we pray in our mind.
3. Contemplation: When we pray in our heart.

e. What did the stranger asked the two disciples? What was the reply from the disciples? (3+2)

Ans. The stranger asked the two disciples what they were talking about. They replied that they were talking about Jesus. The all thought that Jesus was going to be their king but he died three days ago. Even his body had disappeared. Two women went to his grave and they said that Jesus was alive again.
