##### 4. Answer in short

- a. Where did the old woman live? What would she do regularly? (2)  
**Ans.** The old woman lived in Medina. She would throw garbage at the man as he passed her house.
- b. What did Krishna snatch from Sudama? What was in it? (2+1)  
**Ans.** Krishna snatched the cloth bag from Sudama. Roasted grams were in it.
- c. Where did Ria stay? What was the name of the place? (2)

- d. How did Ria describe the orphanage? (2)
