- Name the three different types of soil.

The three types of soil are: Clayey soil, Sandy soil and Garden soil.

- Why do we need clothes?

We need clothes to protect us from heat, cold, rain and insect bites.

- Why do animals need food?

Animals need food to grow, to get energy to do work and to stay healthy and strong.

- What is rumination?

Some animals like cows and buffaloes cut and bites the grass and leaves with their sharp front teeth and swallow it. Later in the day they bring it back to their mouth and chew it for hours. This is called chewing of the cud or rumination.

e. Write three rules to be safe in school.

SECTION – C

5. What is food chain?

All animals depend directly or indirectly on plants for their food. Herbivores depend directly on plants and carnivores eat herbivores. This relationship with the plants is called the food chain.

6. Mention three safety rules we should follow on the road. Draw the traffic signal.

We should always cross the road at the zebra crossing.

Before crossing the road we should look first to the right, then left and then right again and then cross the road when the road is clear.

We must always walk on the footpath.

7. Mention three ways to take care of domestic animals. Name two domestic animals.

Domestic animals should be given wholesome food to eat and clean water to drink.

Their shelter should be cleaned regularly.

If they fall sick they should be taken to a veterinary doctor.

E.g. of domestic animals – dog, cat

8. Mention three ways to keep our houses clean. Why is fresh air and sunlight important for our homes?

(3+2)

Houses should be swept and mopped with phenyl every day. Waste material and garbage should be thrown in a closed dustbin. Drains of kitchens and bathrooms should always be covered to keep mosquitos and cockroaches away.

Fresh air keeps our homes airy and cool in summer. Sunlight kills the germs and keeps the house warm in winter.
