Steps to change font colour.

Step 1- Select the text whose colour you want to change.

Step 2- Click on the Font Colour option down arrow in the Font group on the Home tab.

Step 3- Click on the colour you desire and the colour will be applied to your text.

Ans: Left-alignment – Each line of the text begins with no space from the left margin.

Right-alignment – Each line of the text ends with no space from the right margin.

Center-alignment – Each line of text is equi-spaced from both the margins.

Justify alignment – In Justify alignment there is no space between each line of text and both margins.
